CAMP INFORMATION BY AGE

PRE-KINDER (3-YEAR-OLDS)

This camp is designed for all incoming pre-kinder students. This transitioning camp will help students get familiar with the Spanish language instruction, school routines, transitions and activities in a fun and caring environment that promotes students confidence to start their preschool stage!

PRE-KINDER 4-5 YRS

Every day is full of fun with songs, games, projects, storytelling, outdoor playing and one amazing field trip each session!

KINDERGARTEN

This camp is designed for all incoming kinder grade students. This camp will help students transition into the kindergarten routine, transitions and activities. Our fun, engaging and stimulating curriculum will help them to embrace the new exciting challenges of their kindergarten life!

1ST-4TH GRADE

The program is designed for the abilities and interests of campers entering 1st-4th grade.

SUMMER CAMP THEMES & FIELD TRIPS

Each camp session is packed with fun for every camper. Each camp incorporates Spanish, STEAM, Athletics, and Global Arts in addition to plenty of guided outdoor play. At Aventura Summer Camp at EBI, campers learn Spanish through hands-on experiences! Each session has an overarching theme to guide their explorations.

SESSION I (JUNE 22 - JUNE 26): SUMMER OF FUN

Campers will enjoy the sunshine outside, while burning off some energy during outdoor activities, games, sports and art. This is a sure way to make summer count from the very beginning!

By the end of the camp, they will have the knowledge and skills to recreate projects at home.

SESSION V (JULY 20 - JULY 24): BAY AREA TEAM

SESSION VI (JULY 27 -JULY 31): UNDER THE STARS

Campers will explore the ancient world of space, from stars to planets and even learn about black holes. We'll make our own mini-galaxies, and play with space slime! It's going to be out of this world!

SESSION VII (AUGUST 3 - AUGUST 7): CAMPING OUT

Come and enjoy an adventure camping out. Campers will learn tips about outdoor camping and all related activities such as how to put together a tent, forest safety, hiking, respect for wildlife, knots, bonfires, first aid, compass navigation, games and much more!

SESSION VIII (AUGUST 10-14): EBI OLYMPICS ***EBI STUDENTS ONLY*

At EBI Olympics all campers are winners! During this session, campers will learn about the Olympics' traditions and history. They will feel the excitement of the grand opening and closing ceremonies, the Olympic torch, medals and much more. Campers will practice various outdoor and indoor sports, including team and individual categories like athletic challenges, baseball, basketball and football, often modified in silly and unusual ways.

DISCOUNTS: We offer an “Early Bird” discount of 5% off your entire purchase, for registrations that occur between January 1 and March 3.

REGISTRATIONS: In order to hold your spot for our summer camps you must pay at least 50% at the time of registration, and the remainder no later than May 31.

CAMP PACKAGES: Each camp package (ex: AM Care, Full Camp, PM Care) are sold in one week sessions. Packages cannot be prorated for days missed.

LATE REGISTRATIONS: We request that you register no later than two weeks prior to the start of camp, as this allows us to properly prepare for a good camp experience for all students.

Signups that occur 2 weeks before the starting date will automatically be assessed an additional 10% fee.

LATE PICK UP: If a child is picked-up more than five minutes late from their program, the child will wait in the office and a fee for care will be placed on the family’s account at a rate of \$1 per minute. Charges will be applied with existing credit card on file.

TRANSFERS: If you would like to transfer session packages from one session to another (ie: session I morning care to session II morning care) we will be happy to accommodate, space permitting, with a \$50 processing fee.

Transfers must be requested no later than two weeks prior to the session start date.

WITHDRAWALS/CANCELLATIONS:

If you wish to withdraw from a summer session package there is a 50% non-refundable fee per package per session. EBI must be notified of such request at summer@ebinternacional.org no later than May 31. Should the specific camp fill with a waitlist, you may be eligible to receive the remaining 50% minus the \$50 processing fee paid at the start of the session. **No refunds will be made for any withdrawals requested after May 31.**

Below are some examples of packages per session:

- Morning care + PK AM camp (2 packages)
- Morning care + K-4 camp day + PM care (3 packages)
- PK AM camp + Extended care (2 packages)

If the camp withdrawal is due to an emergency or illness you may be eligible for a partial refund. In this case, medical documentation will be needed to support the claim along with a refund request to summer@ebinternacional.org.

PROGRAM FEES & FINANCIAL POLICIES *Continued*

If the camp is cancelled due to low enrollment you will be issued a full refund for the price paid for that class. In case of cancelation, families will be notified one week before the scheduled start date.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- EBI does not refund nor prorate for days of camp/programs due to illness.
- Session packages and classes are not transferable to other campers.
- Our camp policies apply to all camp cancellations, regardless of original sign-up date.
- Children must be fully potty trained in order to attend Summer Camp at EBI.
- All eligible refunds will be credited via the original payment method.

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ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUMMER CAMP AT EBI

All students attending Summer Camp at EBI must register through Thriva, our registration website.

TO ENROLL ONLINE IN SUMMER CAMP AT EBI:

1. Please visit: ebinternacional.org/about-ebi/summer-camps
2. If you are an existing user, please sign in to your account. If you are new, please create a new account.
3. Click on **“Register Now”**
4. Select the entering grade level for the Fall, press **Continue**
5. Select Class Type: Summer Camps, press **Continue**
6. Select desired camp session, press **Continue**
7. Select options for Extended Day Care for each session, press **Continue**
8. Complete the Student information if you are a new user. Returning User, please review/update information
7. Please make sure to review the courses in your shopping cart for accuracy, and make any necessary changes. (Enrolling another student? Click on **“Add a New Student”** and repeat all the same steps)
9. Click on **Checkout**
10. Review Billing Information and enter payment information. Review policies and Sign. Click on **“Place my Order”** to submit

SUMMER CAMPS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. ARE SNACKS PROVIDED?

A. We provide a snack in the morning and in the afternoon each day for campers. We are a nut-free campus and it is very important that you let us know if your camper has any other food allergies.

Q. IS LUNCH PROVIDED?

A. Lunch is not provided by EBI. Please pack your camper with sufficient food for the day in a labeled lunch box or bag. Campers will not have access to a refrigerator or microwave facility. Please send food that is not temperature sensitive and will not spoil. Since EBI is a nut-free campus, please help us by not sending your camper with any nut products (including nut butters or bars of any kind).

Q. WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD WEAR TO CAMP?

A. Bring your camper in comfortable clothes that are appropriate for the weather. For your campers safety, do not bring you camper in open toe shoes. Your camper is free to bring gear to protect from the sun, such as hats and visors.

Q. CAN MY CHILD BRINGS SUNSCREEN TO SUMMER CAMP?

A. Sun protection is important. We encourage students to wear sunscreen to camp and to bring sunscreen, if needed, to apply during the camp day. Staff members can support, encourage and help children apply sunscreen when needed.

Q. WHERE DO CLASSES TAKE PLACE?

A. All summer sessions will take place at our campus on 410 Alcatraz Avenue, Oakland, CA 94609.

Q. WHAT IS THE OFFICE'S PHONE NUMBER?

Q. WHERE DO I PARK?

A. Alcatraz Campus: You may park on the street, or in our parking lot located on Alcatraz Avenue, next to the church. Cars can't remain there later than 6p.m., or they may be locked in at night!

Q. HOW DO I GET IN THE BUILDING?

A. Please only use the main entrance door. The door code is changed periodically. Door codes will be included in the Welcome Letter sent before each camp session.

Q. DO I HAVE TO SIGN IN AND OUT EVERY TIME I DROP OFF AND PICK UP MY CAMPER?

A. Yes. This is for your camper's security. Please sign in and out every time using the binder located at the front desk.

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
