Pre - kinder

- Location:

 - Campers must be at least three years old at the start of camp
 - There is no previous Spanish language requirement for this age group

There is no language requirement for students in sessions I, II, III and IV.

Summer Camp Themes:

Pre - Kinder - 3rd Grade Themes
